Les Chevaliers des Vins de France are delighted to be able to invite you to an exciting double feature, two weeks apart in June. Come to either one of the tastings or better still come to both. These two events will cover some of the vintages of the world famous and much loved Château Gruaud Larose which was first founded in St. Julien in 1725 and its half French, half Canadian, Great Great Grandchild, the Osoyoos Larose.

The first event will be a vertical tasting of the Château Gruaud Larose.

We will be tasting vintages from as far back as 1983 and 1986, into the nineties with the 1997 and 1999 vintages, followed by three vintages from the 21st Century. The wines being poured at this event have very limited availability, so this will probably be your only opportunity to enjoy these wines. The tasting will be led by one of the most distinguished 'noses' in Canada, Sid Cross.

We will also be pouring the 2003 vintage of the Osoyoos Larose as a link to the next event which takes place on Friday June 27th.

The second event will be a tasting of some of the vintages of the Osoyoos Larose and the Larose Petale with Pascal Madevon, winemaker and manager of the vineyard. You will also be trying your own skills as a winemaker because Pascal will be bringing the following with him from Osoyoos:

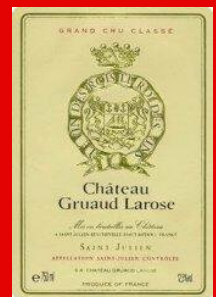
- ◆ Merlot 2007
- ◆ Cabernet Franc 2007
- ◆ Malbec 2007
- ◆ Petit Verdot 2007
- ◆ Cabernet Sauvignon 2007

With the above, the attendees at the event will have the opportunity to try blending their own wine and who knows, if you produce a good product, you may have a new career ahead of you in the Okanagan! Château Gruaud Larose also uses these same five varietals, so perhaps your new career could see you in St. Julien.
